

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1702

**WATERFORD SANITARY DISTRICT #1
RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN
TO ADOPT NEW QUARTERLY USER FEES**

The Commissioners of the Town of Waterford Sanitary District No. 1, Township of Waterford, Racine County, Wisconsin, at their regular and duly-noticed meeting, do hereby pass and adopt the following Ordinance implementing new rates for all classifications of customers.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of December, 2016, at Waterford, Wisconsin the Town of Waterford Sanitary District #1 (the 'District') by Resolution Number 1601 adopted the 2017 Budget which resulted in no overall general increase or decrease in user fees; and

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of February, 2015, at Waterford, the District, by Ordinance 1501 adopted said Ordinance Implementing a New Cost of Service Model (the 'COSM') in Accordance With the Previously Adopted May 19, 2014 Rate Study. Said COSM became the bases for establishing all future sewer user charges; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Public Service Commission staff previously directed the District to create and adopt user rates for certain customers with customer owned grinder pumps in such a manner as to not incur costs associated with District owned grinder pumps; and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 2017 the Commissioners adopted Ordinance 1701 defining customers who qualify for the customer owned grinder pump rate.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Town of Waterford Sanitary District No. 1, Township of Waterford, Racine County, Wisconsin, as follows:

1. The sewer user charge shall be changed using the COSM updated as of February 2017.
2. The new rates are not intended to increase or decrease the overall general use charge. Any change in user fees for any classification of customer is due to shifting the cost of District owned grinder pumps away from certain customers who own their grinder pumps.
3. Customers who own their grinder pumps, are unmetered, and are billed a flat fixed rate shall be billed \$110.92 per quarter per UCE.
4. All other customers who are on a gravity system or a District own grinder pump, are unmetered, and are billed a flat fixed rate shall be billed \$117.72 per quarter per UCE.
5. All metered customers shall be billed \$8.72 per thousand gallons, but not less than the minimum charge per the District ordinance.
6. These new rates will go into effect with the second quarter billing (on or about July 1, 2017)


